The Secretariat of the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) presents its compliments to the IAEA's Member States and has the honour to draw their attention to the International Training Course on the Implementation of Nuclear Security Series No. 13 Recommendations on Physical Protection of Nuclear Material and Nuclear Facilities (INFCIRC/225/Revision 5) to be held in Chakri, Pakistan, from 11 to 15 December 2017.

The purpose of this course is to provide participants with an improved understanding of the implementation of IAEA Nuclear Security Series No. 13, *Nuclear Security Recommendations on Physical Protection of Nuclear Material and Nuclear Facilities (INFCIRC/225/Revision 5)*.

The attached Information Sheet provides further details of the course.

The course will be held in English.

Member States are invited to nominate one or more participants for this course. Member States are strongly encouraged to identify suitable women participants.

The IAEA is generally not in a position to bear the travel and other costs of participants in the course. The IAEA has, however, limited funds at its disposal to help meet the cost of attendance of certain participants. Such assistance may be offered upon specific request to normally one participant per country provided that, in the IAEA's view, the participant on whose behalf assistance is requested will make an important contribution to his or her State's nuclear security arrangements. The application for financial support should be made at the time of nominating the participant.

It should be noted that compensation is not payable by the IAEA for any damage to or loss of personal property. The IAEA also does not provide health insurance coverage for participants in meetings, workshops or training courses or for consultants. Arrangements for private insurance coverage on an individual basis should therefore be made. The IAEA will, however, provide insurance coverage for accidents and illnesses that clearly result from any work performed for the IAEA.

Nominations should be submitted through the established official channels not later than **24 September 2017** for the attention of the Scientific Secretary of the course, Mr Douglas Shull, Division of Nuclear Security, Department of Nuclear Safety and Security, IAEA, Vienna International Centre, PO Box 100, 1400 Vienna, Austria (Email: <a href="D.Shull@iaea.org">D.Shull@iaea.org</a>). The full names and complete contact details (including postal address, telephone/fax numbers, and email address) of nominated participants should be provided.
