A. Objectives

The purpose of this course is to provide participants with an improved understanding of the implementation of IAEA Nuclear Security Series No. 13, *Nuclear Security Recommendations on Physical Protection of Nuclear Material and Nuclear Facilities (INFCIRC/225/Revision 5)*.

The course will also discuss nuclear security support activities carried out by the International Atomic Energy (IAEA) that can assist Member States in strengthening physical protection measures at the relevant facilities and in enhancing cooperation between the various national authorities in charge of nuclear security functions.

B. Nature of the Course

The course will consist of lectures, discussions and small-group exercises. During the small group exercises, the participants will apply the course objectives and their experience as they work through practical exercises related to the implementation of the recommendations for physical protection of nuclear material and nuclear facilities contained in IAEA Nuclear Security Series No. 13 (NSS-13). These practical exercises will require the use of all the major concepts presented in the course, resulting in reinforcement and a review of the recommendations for physical protection of nuclear material and nuclear facilities.

C. Target Audience

The participants should be drawn primarily from their respective States' regulatory bodies and competent authorities that prepare associated regulations, and they should be responsible for designing, implementing and/or assessing their respective States' nuclear security regimes and the regulatory framework for physical protection of nuclear material and nuclear facilities. The course will also be beneficial for the staff of design and operation organizations that are involved in the implementation of the recommendations contained in NSS-13.

Representatives of organizations not directly involved in these kinds of security activities, including facility operators' nuclear security management staff and related law enforcement agencies, may attend the course, if space is available.

E. Application Procedure

Nominations should be submitted through InTouch+ (<https://Intouchplus.iaea.org>) or using the attached **Nomination Form**. Completed requests should be endorsed by the competent national authority (e.g. Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Permanent Mission to the IAEA, or National Atomic Energy Authority), or by an organization invited to participate, and returned through the established official channels. They must be received by the IAEA not later than **24 September 2017**. Nominations received after that date or applications sent directly by individuals or by private institutions cannot be considered. Nominating Governments and invited organizations will be informed in due course of the names of the selected candidates and at that time full details will be given on the procedures to be followed with regard to administrative and financial matters.

F. Expenditures and Grants

No registration fee is charged to participants. The IAEA is generally not in a position to bear the travel and other costs of participants in the course. The IAEA has, however, limited funds at its disposal to help meet the cost of attendance of certain participants. Such assistance may be offered upon specific request to normally **one participant** per country provided that, in the IAEA's view, the participant on whose behalf assistance is requested will make an important contribution to his/her State's nuclear security arrangements. The application for financial support should be made at the time of designating the participant. If Governments wish to apply for a grant on behalf of one of their experts, they should address specific requests to the IAEA to this effect. Governments should ensure that applications for grants are submitted by **24 September 2017** through InTouch+ (<https://Intouchplus.iaea.org>) or using a signed **Grant Application Form (Form C)**. Approved grants will be issued in the form of a lump sum payment that usually covers **only part of the cost of attendance**.
