STATEMENT OF INTENT

Concluded between Minister of Science and Technology of the Republic of Korea on one side and Deputy Minister of Industry and Trade of the Czech Republic and the Chairman of the State Office for Nuclear Safety of the Czech Republic on the other side.

- 1. Considering the economic and social importance of nuclear energy in today's international scene, both sides recognized that the close cooperation in the field of nuclear energy between the two countries would play a vital role in opening a new era toward the 21st century of common prosperity, mutual benefits and shared the view that the two countries would make efforts to initiate and strengthen the cooperation in the peaceful uses of nuclear energy and nuclear safety.
- Both sides recognized that both countries are Member States of the International Atomic Energy Agency and parties to the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons.
- 3. Both sides also recognized that it is necessary for the two countries to conclude a Nuclear Cooperation Agreement on the governmental level and arrangements on the research institute level to promote the cooperation for peaceful uses of nuclear energy and nuclear safety between the two countries as soon as possible.
- Both sides would expand and strengthen cooperation in the nuclear field in the form
 of exchange of scientists and engineers, joint research, information exchange and
 other cooperative activities.
