## Freedom of Information Request re ČEZ, a. s. Document "Postup a pravidla pro řešení kauzy hutní materiály ETE/EDU" on Non-Compliance of Pipeline components

Dear Sir or Madam,

as an environmental organization, follows with great interest the safety of nuclear operations in the Czech Republic, among other countries.

We have obtained the ČEZ document "Postup a pravidla pro řešení kauzy hutní materiály ETE/EDU" dated 27.2.2020 regarding the non-compliance of pipeline components by a supplier. We enclose a copy of this document on the following pages.

Under Freedom of Information and with reference to the Public Information Access Act, on 10.6.2021 asked for the following data from ČEZ as a publicly owned shareholder (see our letter attached):

The non-compliance of pipeline components was discovered in 2018 according to the document, p 3.

- Did ČEZ, a. s. inform the nuclear regulator State Office for Nuclear Safety (SÚJB) of this non-conformity?
  - If so, what was the SÚJB reaction and how was SUJB involved in designing the pipe-line review?
  - Has SUJB inquired which companies were involved in the manufacturing, delivery and installation of non-complying pipes and were other nuclear power plants which are likely of having bought and installed piping from those companies been warned? If ČEZ did not inform SÚJB, why was this not done?
- Did ČEZ, a. s. inform the World Association of Nuclear Operators (WANO) of this nonconformity?

If so, what was the WANO reaction?

If ČEZ did not inform WANO, why was this not done?

 This document is referring to another report (...Takýto hutní material bude ověřen v rámci kapitoly 3 – Rozsah a způsob....), which we also consider of importance for nuclear safety and thus of importance for the environment which needs to be kept safe from possible radioactive releases.

ČEZ replied on 2.7.2021 that they will not provide this information.

Therefore, we ask you as the competent authority to provide answers to our above questions under Freedom of Information.
