thank you very much for your reply of September 3<sup>rd</sup> to our Freedom of Information Request (your reference number SÚJB/POD/19400/2021).

Under Freedom of Information and with reference to the Public Information Access Act, we would like to ask for the following additional clarifications to our request:

**Question 1)**

- Based on the inspected “heat” (cz: tavby) EDU 443/41 and ETE 400/22, exactly how many components were inspected, how many components passed inspection and how many failed inspection?

**Question 2)**

- How did SÚJB informed the partner organisations about the results of material inspection? When exactly was this information transmitted to which partner organization?

**Question 3)**

- Did SÚJB create a blacklist of manufacturers and suppliers based on the result of these inspections? If so, when was this list created and when did it enter into force? If not, why was such a list not created?
