Dear Ing. Merxbauer, Ph.D.,

thank you very much for your reply of October 7th to our Freedom of Information Request (your reference number SÚJB/OS/23230/2021).

Under Freedom of Information and with reference to the Public Information Access Act, we would like to ask for the following additional clarifications to our request regarding question 2:

- In your reply of October 7th to our Freedom of Information Request (your reference number SÚJB/OS/23230/2021), you state that SÚJB informed the international partners about the non-compliance of pipeline components at the **June 2019 WWER-Forum** in Bulgaria. In your reply of August 3rd to our Freedom of Information Request (your reference number SÚJB/OS/17794/2021), you state that SÚJB also informed the Slovak nuclear regulator ÚJD about the non-compliance, no precise date specified when this information happened.
- In our original Freedom of Information Request of July 24th, we enclosed the ČEZ document "Postup a pravidla pro řešení kauzy hutní materiály ETE/EDU" dated 27.2.2020. This document shows on page 3 that the non-compliance of pipeline components was **discovered in 2018**, no precise date specified, i. e. at least 5,5 months, but potentially up to 18 months before the June 2019 SÚJB information to the international partners.

Question 2, additional clarification of timeline:

- Why did SÚJB only inform the international partners 5,5 to eighteen months after the discovery of the non-compliance of pipeline components?
- If there was a previous information, at what date exactly did SÚJB first inform which partner of this non-compliance?
